We had a good turnout for the **April event**, especially in Closed Wheel with several close races in the different classes. We invite the Baby Grands to come back anytime. The Legends had their usual high-spirited, intense competition and had one (mere inches!) of the closest finishes in HMRC history. The Open Wheels are showing some good growth in FA and FF. HST participants, notice you made the photo pages!

**Electronic time and scoring:** After much research and driver polling, the decision was made to charge a one-time fee of \$100 to help purchase and maintain the AMB System. We were reluctant to change the entry fees and by keeping to the current levels, we remain more in tune with the COMMA philosophy. Rental transponders will be available to COMMA members for \$25 per weekend. Direct wire-in transponders will be priced in the area of \$250 and the rechargeable units will be approximately \$280. Both will be for sale in the Racers' Store on the first floor of the tower. If you already have an AMB transponder, it will work with this system and the only charge will be the one-time fee of \$100 for racers and \$50 for HST. We are going to make every effort to have the system in place for the May 31<sup>st</sup>, June 1<sup>st</sup> weekend. Remember, it's all or nothing; all the race groups must have transponders or it torpedoes the whole system.

**High Speed Touring** participants who have at least three days participating in HST and want their lap times on the AMB system printout will be charged a \$50 one-time fee; then they can either rent or purchase a transponder. We want to make it perfectly clear that it is NOT necessary to have a transponder in order to participate in HST. HST rules and regulations will be enforced as usual; cars will be spaced, no passing except in designated straights, off track excursions and spins bring out the black flag, etc. By providing the HST group the opportunity to utilize the AMB system, HMRC and COMMA are in no way encouraging competition in this group. It is only to provide an accurate record of lap times and allow participants to track their progress.

Due to popular demand, the **ProSpecRacer Ford** series will be the guest series for the August round. Oklahoma Joe's BBQ is the title sponsor and will provide dinner on Saturday. The Southwest **Formula Mazda** Series will also join us in August, so it will be a busy schedule. We have expanded the August round to a three-day event with most of the practice for the ProSpecRacerFords and Formula Mazdas scheduled for Friday, the 22<sup>nd</sup>. We may have to run a little later in the afternoon to get everything in, but what the heck, it doesn't get dark until 8:30 or 9:00 in August. We will all be full of Oklahoma Joe's BBQ long before then.

Also due to popular demand, the **El sol y la luna II Six-hour Enduro** will be run in September. The **Spec Miatas** are the guest series for September, and we anticipate that they will take the opportunity to participate in the Enduro while they are here. September will also become a three-day event with a similar schedule to the one we used in March with Friday night practice, etc. Start making plans for lights and driver teams now because we are sure you have heard that the March event was one of the most fun events we have ever had.

We **appreciate** everyone who helps make COMMA work. The recent training sessions at the Crash Fire Rescue school have made our workers more knowledgeable and efficient, making Hallett an even safer place to race. A special big thank you to Barbara Joyce and Sofia Hutchens in T&S as they switch to the new AMB system. Just think, you will have printouts of practice and qualifying sessions as well as copies of official race results. You can say good-bye to the hassle of finding someone to time you!
